ICE HOCKEY

Did you know that hockey is believed to have come from simple stick and ball games played in the 18th and 19th centuries in the United Kingdom?

The origin of ice hockey was called bandy, a game that started in the Middle Ages. Just as for most of all other sports, the game of bandy took its modern form during the 19th century in England, more exactly in the Fen district on the East coast. From the Fen district the game was spread to London and from London to the Continent during the second half of the 19th century. British soldiers who were in eastern Canada brought the game to the North American continent in the 1850's and '60's. You could find similar games there, played by immigrants (mainly





Dutch) and by Indians. That means there were a number of different games played on skates with a stick and ball and with different rules in America before ice hockey was invented.

Famous Black Sportsmen

ANDREW WATSON

He was a Scottish Footballer born in 1856 on the 24th of May-8th of March 1921.He was the one of the first black people to play football. He won the Scottish cup in 1881 and 1882.He was the first person to play in the English cup. He was very wealthy because his dad was a sugar planter. He *played for 7 football teams. He had 1 sister called Anneta Watson.* Him, his father and sister moved to Britain. His father died in London 1869.He also took part in athletic competitions. He retired in 1910.He was buried at Richmond cemetery.



Muhammad Ali



He was the greatest boxer of all time and lived until 2016 on the 3rd of June. In 1960, he got the gold medal at the Olympics. He got 56 wins and only 5 losses. He even has his own museum! He started training as an amateur boxer when he was 12. He became a Muslim in 1961. When he was 22 he changed his name to Muhammad Ali.

As a Muslim, Ali was initially affiliated with <u>Elijah Muhammad</u>'s <u>Nation of Islam</u> (NOI). He later disavowed the NOI, adhering to <u>Sunni Islam</u>. Outside of boxing, he achieved success as a spoken word artist and did two albums.

<u>Dwayne Johnson</u>

Dwayne Johnson is an American-Canadian actor, former football player, producer, businessman and wrestler. In 2019, he quit wrestling. He was born on the 2^{nd} of May 1972. He also has a prosthetic forehead. Recently, his latest movie is Black Adam. His father is Rocky Johnson and his mother is Ata Fitisemany Maiva. He became an actor in 1999.



ARTHUR ASHE



Arthur Ashe is an American tennis player. He was born on 10^{th} of July 1943 and died 6^{th} of February 1993. Because he had a heart attack that required bypass surgery, he had to retire. In 1975, he was the first black person to win Wimbledon and the first black person to do a grand slam.

JESSE OWENS

He is an American field and track athlete. He was born on 12th September in1913 and died on the 31st of March in 1980.At the age of 66; he died because of Lung Cancer. His speed record is 10.3 seconds and he broke the world record for the 200-metre race (20.3 seconds). He had won 4 medals.





DIRECT FREE KICK

A DIRECT FREE KICK IS AWARDED IF:

- CHARGES
- JUMPS AT
- KICKS OR ATTEMPTS TO KICK
- PUSHES
- STRIKES OR ATTEMPTS TO STRIKE (INCLUDING HEAD-BUTT)
- TACKLES OR CHALLENGES
- TRIPS OR ATTEMPTS TO TRIP

PENALTY KICK

A PENALTY KICK IS AWARDED IF A PLAYER:

*CHARGES, JUMPS, KICKS OR ATTEMPTS TO KICK, PUSHES, STRIKES OR ATTEMPTS TO STRIKE (INCLUDING HEAD BUTT), TACKLES OR CHALLENGES, TRIPS OR ATTEMPTS TO TRIP IN THEIR PENALTY AREA.

THROW IN

A THROW IN IS AWARDED IF A PLAYER:

A THROW-IN IS AWARDED TO THE OPPONENTS OF THE PLAYER WHO LAST TOUCHED THE BALL WHEN THE WHOLE OF THE BALL PASSES OVER THE TOUCHLINE, ON THE GROUND OR IN THE AIR.

GOAL KICK

A GOAL KICK IS AWARDED IF:

A GOAL KICK IS AWARDED WHEN THE WHOLE OF THE BALL PASSES OVER THE GOAL LINE, ON THE GROUND OR IN THE AIR, HAVING LAST TOUCHED A PLAYER OF THE ATTACKING TEAM, AND A GOAL IS NOT SCORED.

THE CORNER KICK

A CORNER KICK IS AWARDED IF:

A CORNER KICK IS AWARDED WHEN THE WHOLE OF THE BALL PASSES OVER THE GOAL LINE, ON THE GROUND OR IN THE AIR, HAVING LAST TOUCHED A PLAYER OF THE DEFENDING TEAM, AND A GOAL IS NOT SCORED.

"SIR! SIR! Your suit is red!" shouted an elf in a hurry,



How to Care for Rabbits in the Winter by Rosie



As the dark winter days draw near once more, as pet owners we should be starting to plan for the health and well-being of the animals that remain outside during the cold and wet conditions.

Our weather can be very cold and it helps to be prepared for any extreme temperatures. Rabbits in particular are at risk of being affected by the cold and ice. In the wild, rabbits live underground which offers them natural protection from the elements.

Weatherproof the rabbit hutch

Looking after rabbits is easier when you have a suitable hutch for them to live in. You will already have bought a good sized hutch that is secure and well ventilated, but if it is time for an upgrade you will find a wide range of high quality hutches.

- Place your hutch away from draughts and damp areas, anywhere that they will be exposed to the cold weather from all sides.
- Raising your rabbit hutch off of the ground will help to keep the cold from entering through the floor and will keep your rabbits clear of puddles that can creep into their living space.
- Look around for gaps in the hutch that the cold and rain can really work through. Repair these with small pieces of wood, or even with sturdy cardboard to keep the cold at bay.
- Check the roof carefully for any damage that may allow leaks into the hutch and repair these straight away. Once water gets inside it will be harder to dry it out.
- If you feel that the hutch is more open than you'd like, put up some beach style wind-breakers around the outside to offer a little extra protection.
- Move the hutch into a garden shed, summer house or garage if you have the space. This will offer lots of protection in the icy weather and give them somewhere to play as well. Just be sure that the areas are well ventilated.

How to keep rabbits warm in the winter

- Provide cosy bedroom areas inside the hutch where your rabbits can snuggle. Cardboard boxes
 or pet carriers are an excellent solution for this. Otherwise a little hideaway from The Pet
 Express will work wonders for making your rabbit feel warm and safe.
- Ensure there is lots of soft, warm bedding inside the hutch and refresh it on a regular basis. This will also act as extra insulation from the cold and wind outside.
- If you have only one rabbit, consider getting a companion. This will not only prevent loneliness, but will also provide extra warmth when they snuggle together on cold days.

Food and nutrition

- Encourage your rabbits to forage more inside their hutch. This will keep them occupied during longer spells spent inside and help to keep their body temperature up.
- Your rabbits will need to eat more during the winter months in order to keep up their body weight and therefore keep up their body temperature. Add fresh food daily and top up throughout the day if they are getting through it quickly.
- Wrap water bottles in bubble wrap or an old sock. This will help to keep the frost at bay and prevent the water from icing over when the temperature plummets overnight.

Other things to consider

- Rabbits do not hibernate in the winter, so will still need a good level of exercise to keep their joints mobile and to relieve boredom.
- Ensure that your rabbits have access to their run as much as possible, which you can
 weatherproof in the same way as the hutch.
- Nothing can beat quality time that they spend with you, so you should ensure that this does not change in the winter. Try to spend more time with them if possible, as they will not be in their runs as often and may feel lonely.

Method:



Stir in a teaspoonful of sugar and a drop of peppermint essence.


Top with squirty cream, a crushed candy cane and grated or crumbled milk chocolate. Finish off with a candy cane to stir!
