On Saturday 7th October, we had our first cross country event. What a fantastic turnout we had - we think it was the best we have ever had and our school definitely had the most runners!!

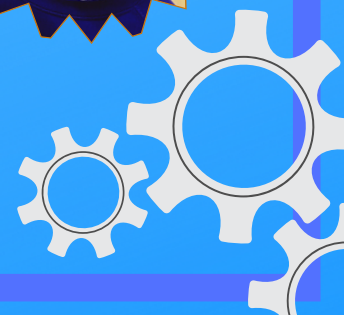
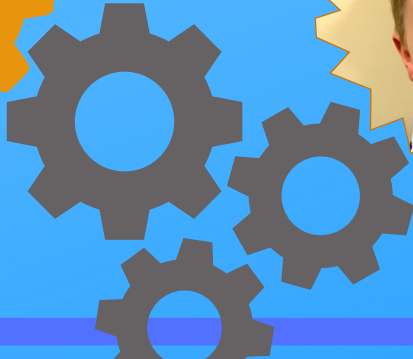
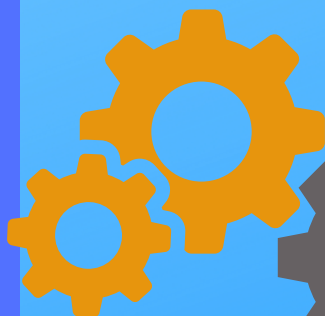
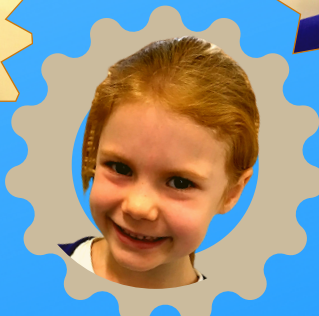
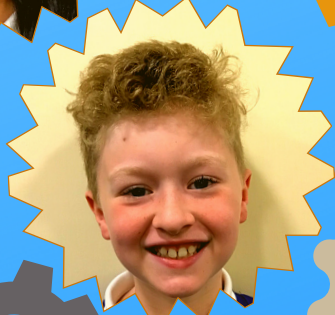
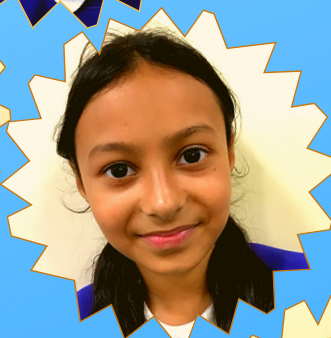
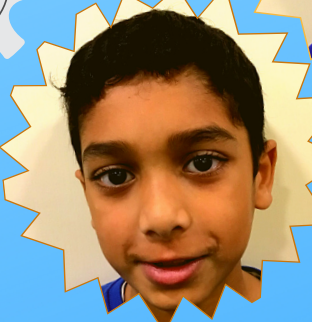
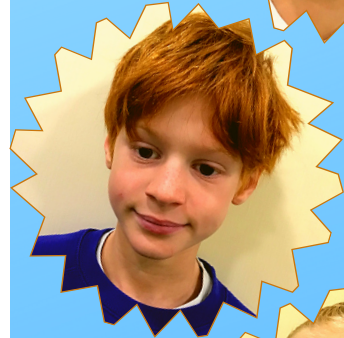
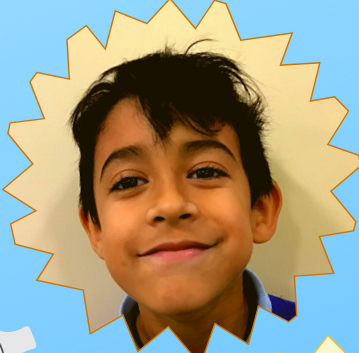
