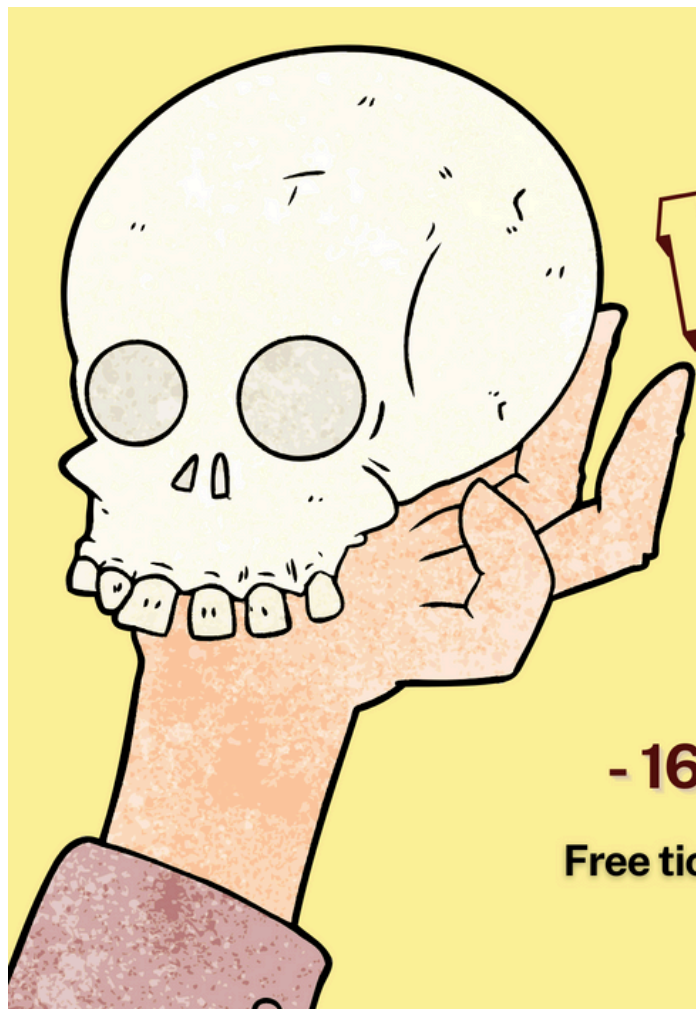

Every year, children in Year 1 are required to sit the National Phonics Screening Check. Children who do not achieve a 'pass' score in the Summer Term of Year 1 are required to sit the check the following year, when they are nearing the end of Year 2.


