I am writing to provide an update and confirm arrangements for the following end of term activities for Year six pupils:

### **Year Six Performances**

There will be two performances for families to attend. These will be held on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> July at 6pm. A maximum of **two** family members per pupil is welcome to attend.

### **Leavers' Services**

There will be a Year 6 Leavers' Service for parents and carers at All Saints Church on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> July. A maximum of **two** family members per pupil is welcome to attend. Doors open at 1.45pm. The service will start at 2pm.

### **End of Year Leavers' Party**

We invite children to join us for an outdoor party on Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> July from 5pm – 7pm.

Children will enjoy refreshments including pizza and cake. Dietary requirements will be fully catered for.

Children are welcomed to wear their own clothes, but please ensure that footwear is appropriate as the party will be held outdoors on the school field and playground. Mobile phones will not be permitted. If a child brings their mobile phone, it will be looked after in the School Office until the end of the party.

Children should arrive at the gate onto the main playground at 5pm. Please ensure that an adult collects your child at the end of the party at 7pm. We will not permit any children to walk or cycle home unaccompanied. Please complete the survey on School Spider to provide your permission for your child to attend the party. Please note that you will need to be logged in to the parent portal to access the permission survey.

## Guard of Honour

On the last day of school, Wednesday 24th July, staff will provide a guard of honour as children leave the school for the last time. Up to two family members are welcome to join us for this so you may take photographs if you wish.

You will be invited to come forward when it is your child's turn to pass through the guard of honour. Children will pass through the guard of honour in alphabetical order.

The Guard of Honour will start at 3.30pm with Miss Rennocks' class followed by Miss Buckley's class. Parents/carers should arrive at 3.20pm if you wish to join us. Please follow directions from staff about where you need to queue whilst waiting for your child's turn.
