Year 2	Phonics screening Test (selected pupils only	Week beginning 10 th June 2024	Phonics test re-taken by pupils who did not take or did not pass the test in Year 1. Children who passed the phonics screening test in Year 1 do not re-take it.	
Year 2	Up until this academic year, children in Year 2 also took national tests in the summer term. These tests are optional from this year. Pupils in Year 2 will sit these tests to inform and support their teacher's assessment. They will be completed in such a way as to avoid causing stress for children as they only contribute one small piece of the jigsaw we put together to assess children's overall attainment and progress in Year 2.

Sing-along Shine-along

I would like to clarify information regarding the Sing-along Shine-along events. We have planned these events as an opportunity to get people of different ages together to enjoy a bit of a singsong.

There is a lot of research that shows that music can have a positive impact on mental health and anxiety levels. You may have family members who are recently bereaved, lonely and isolated. This is an opportunity for us to welcome in parents, carers, grandparents and wider family members.

I am aware that there has been confusion with which year groups and children are involved. This is not about families coming to sing with their own children. This is about us hosting an afternoon for any family members, including parents/carers, grandparents etc, who wish to come into school for an afternoon of singing to lift their spirits.

There will a small group of children in the hall helping to host this event but it is not the whole year group and it is not the case that children are performing. Pupils will join in the singsong with the guests who arrive.

We plan to remove reference to year groups from future notices about the next events as this appears to have caused confusion, with families thinking that they must only come on the days their child's year group is involved.

Any family members can join us for a singalong in the school hall at 2pm on 20th June and the 18th July.


Join us at our Market Place after school to support local businesses! Stalls will be set up outside at the front of school

Lift Your Spirits High!






Our first Sing-along Shine-along event was a great success!


