Uniform Union Donations

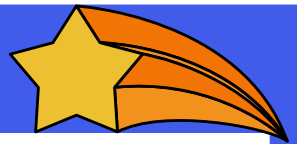

Children are invited to sign up for the workshops, provided that they commit to attending the parade with their parents or carers on both parade days, Saturday 22nd & Sunday 23rd June

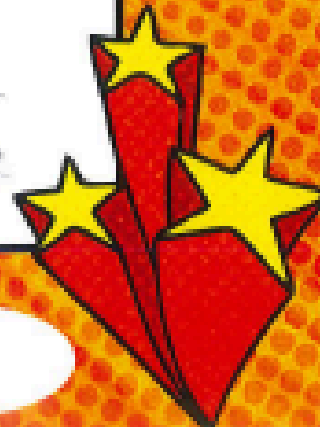
If you are unable to take your child to Chester to participate in the parades, please do not sign them up for the art workshop, as they will carry the items they make in both parades.

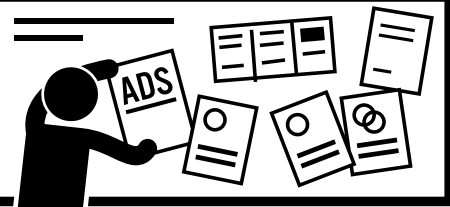
