There is a free Festival of Archaeology youth event at Chester Castle on 20th July.



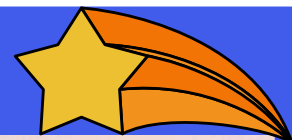

Fantastic results! In the 600 metres race, Leon led the pack from the start and extended his lead throughout the race to take gold.

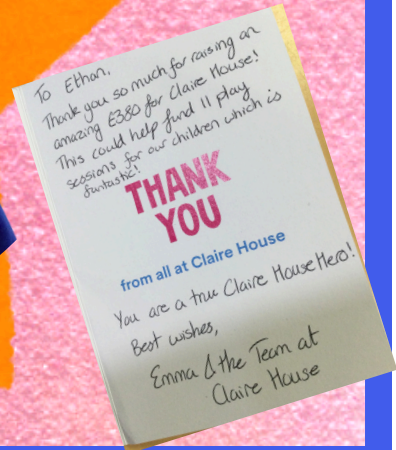
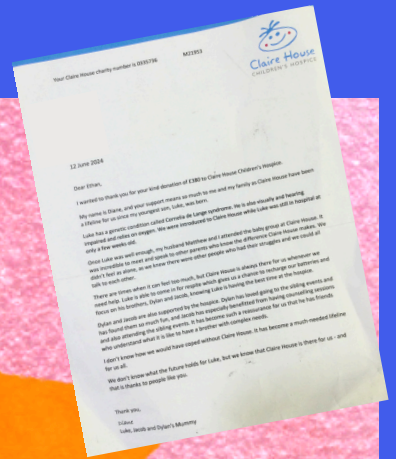
