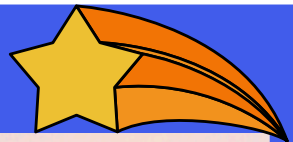

He then held an assembly to share how he faced challenges to compete in sport and his story of resilience really resonated with the children. They reflected on challenges in their own life and how they could persevere like Michael to achieve their dreams.

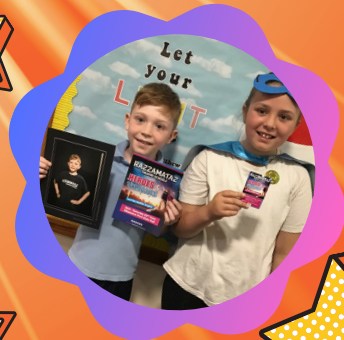
