Message from Headteacher

I look forward to welcoming children and families back to school on Tuesday 3rd September. A special welcome to new pupils and families joining us in Reception and children who are transferring from other schools to join us at Hoole in September. We are very happy to welcome you to our school family.

We have planned an opportunity for parents and carers to come in and meet the teachers in your child's year group. These sessions will provide information about timetables, routines, assessments and homework.

Meet the Teacher sessions will be held on Thursday 5th September from 3.30pm-4.00pm and from 4.00-4.30pm. Please come into school via the main entrance via the office and you will be directed to where the meeting for your child's year group is being held.

These sessions are designed to provide an overview of the year ahead and what your child can look forward to over the coming year.

Teachers will be unable to engage in discussions with individual parents/carers about any specific issues relating to their child. If you need to do this, you would need to arrange a separate meeting with the relevant teacher. This can be done via contact with the School Office.

Formal Parents' Evenings are held termly. This terms Parents' Evening will take place during the week beginning 13th October for years 1-6 and week beginning 21st October for Reception classes. We will write to families at the start of each term with information about what your child's class will be learning. These curriculum newsletters will be send out to you in early September. We also have a wealth of information about our curriculum available on our school website in the Curriculum section.

Message from Headteacher

This newsletter provides information regarding PE and Forest School Days for this term. Please note that there will be no Forest School running on the first week of term, so children need to come dressed in school uniform.

Forest School lessons start from Monday 9th September.

From Wednesday 4th September, PE lessons will begin, so pupils should come prepared for PE from Wednesday onwards. Thank you again for your cooperation in maintaining high standards with regards to school uniform and PE kit.

Our Story Shack is accessible during the summer break and during school hours from September.. Please feel free to use the Story Shack to borrow books and games to keep your child busy. All we ask is that items are returned in good condition for another family to use in the future.

Parents and Carers of Year 6 pupils attending the forthcoming residential trip are invited to an information evening where the Year 6 teachers will talk through the logistics of the trip, provide key information and be available to answer any questions.

The meeting will take place from 5.30pm in a year 6 classroom so parents and carers can enter school via the School Office.

Families with children in Key Stage 2 who are receiving benefits, may be also entitled to Free School Meals. If your child has any food allergies or intolerances that we have not already recorded, please speak to the School Office on the first day back at school.
