Pupils walking home unaccompanied

I understand that, as children get older, they are permitted to walk home from school on their own without adult supervision.

Where I receive reports of poor behaviour choices by children walking home alone, I will contact relevant parents/carers to discuss this and recommend that pupils are accompanied from school for a period of time. We talk a lot to children about shining their lights and encourage them to do this when out and about in the local community, as well as in school.

Staff & Governors' meeting

Staff and governors joined for a productive meeting on Wednesday evening to review the current school self-evaluation and school improvement targets for this academic year.

Representatives from the Governing board worked in groups with lunchtime supervisory staff, administration staff, teaching assistants and teachers to discuss the strengths of our school and contribute to identifying how we can continue to improve aspects of school life.



Emily was awarded a certificate for being Star of the Week at Razzamataz Theatre School!


Maisy, Alice, Ethan, Luna, Daisy and Morgan participated in a triathlon last weekend and excelled in their swimming, cycling and running!
