

Message from Headteacher

We are always keen to work in partnership with parents and carers. We have got several events planned over coming weeks that families may join us for.

On 10th October from 4-5pm, we welcome families of pupils in Reception to Year four for an interactive Maths event. Teaching methods in Mathematics have changed over time and this can be baffling for parents and carers supporting their children at home. We hope that this event will be enjoyable and informative.

I strongly urge as many parents and carers as possible to attend the My Happy Mind information sessions. These are being held on 15th October from 9-10am and 5-6pm. If parents and carers wish to nominate a grandparent to attend one of these sessions, that is fine. We ask that everyone attending registers via the School Spider survey.

My Happy Mind is a transformational programme which teaches children about how their brain reacts to stress and unfamiliar situations. It is sharply focused on enhancing children's self-image and resilience. Children are taught positive strategies to manage stress, behaviour and their responses.

On 7th November from 4-5pm, we have a phonics information session for families of children in Reception. During this event, parents and carers will be introduced to the phonics programme we use in school, Little Wandle.

This phonics scheme aims to ensure that children become fluent and confident readers as quickly as possible. During the workshop, families will be introduced to the structure of the scheme, told about how phonics learning develops and given information to support early reading development at home.

In addition, booking is now open for Parents' Evenings which are being held between Monday 14th October and Wednesday 23rd October. Appointments may be booked via School Spider.

I look forward to welcoming you into school over the coming weeks.

Menu Change

In replacement of the normal menu on Thursday 3rd October, we will be holding an American themed feast! On the menu will be hotdogs (pork/veggie), served with french fries and peas or beans. 



Eleanor and Charles participated in the Northwest Duathlon and won a wonderful medal!


Elsie received a high merit for her dance examination!




